Seppelt Sheoak Riesling has a fine heritage in its blend of Riesling grapes; from the very cool Strathbogies and the cool Drumborg Vineyard which has developed an impressive reputation for outstanding Riesling grapes since it was planted over three decades ago.

This is Victorian cool-climate at its best - crisp, young and fresh, with zingy citrus appeal.
