Produced and bottled in Italy, Riccadonna is not only Australia's biggest selling Asti brand, it is also the biggest selling imported wine in Australia.

Riccadonna is a classic example of the delicate and fragrant sparkling wines produced from the Moscato Bianco grape, grown within accredited D.O.C.G of the Asti province in the respected Piedmont region of Northern Italy.

Colour

Riccadonna Asti is a pale gold colour with a fine persistent bead. The bead is finer due to the lower "fizziness" - a character of quality Asti.



Nose

The bouquet is pleasantly fragrant with inviting floral Muscat fruit characters.



Palate

The palate is dominated by fresh, rich and flavoursome fruit complemented by a touch of sweetness. The sweetness contributes to the roundness and attractive mouthfeel whilst the cleansing acidity is present to balance the wine. The finish is soft and lingering with soft fruit.
