## Limestone Coast Unoaked Chardonnay 2003

Rouge Homme has established a tradition of creating wines of an excellent quality since 1952.

This 2003 Unoaked Chardonnay was made with fruit sourced from Padthaway, which is located within South Australia's rugged Limestone Coast region.

Untouched by oak, this wine has an abundance of fresh fruit aromas and flavours, along with a creamy complexity that has resulted from time spent on lees.

### Vintage Conditions

The Limestone Coast experienced an excellent vintage in 2003, receiving rainfall at just the right time during the growing season. In turn, the fruit ripened evenly and harvest was on time and went very well, with the quality of the Chardonnay fruit being exceptionally high overall.

Pale straw with green hues.



### Nose

Aromas of lychee and citrus with subtle nutty aromas from less stirring, which added complexity.



### Palate

Full-flavoured, lychee, passionfruit and grapefruit flavours; subtle creamy lees complexity; persistent fruit on the finish.
